

## Youth Group Facilitator

<b>Time Commitment:</b>	One 2 hour meeting per month, plus reporting to the HOPE Board of Directors bimonthly
<b>Honorarium:</b>	\$50/month honorarium is available (for each position)

HOPE is currently seeking facilitators for our LGBTT2IQQAA youth groups in Halton Hills and Oakville.

### Duties

Reporting to the HOPE Board of Directors, the successful candidate will:

- provide support to youth with multiple social and mental health wellness issues;
- plan and lead monthly support groups in Oakville or Halton Hills;
- work with parents, social workers and HOPE partners to ensure the safety and relevance of the group for individuals;
- create venues to promote the youth groups within the Halton region;
- promote the group within youth and other networks;
- liaise with schools and school board to get the groups' information distributed and displayed;
- prepare monthly reports outlining and detailing the group's activities and progress.

### Qualifications & Attributes

- SSW/CYW designation or equivalent is preferred;
- experience in group facilitation and youth support work is preferred;
- demonstrated comfort in the LGBTT2IQQAA community is required;
- experience working in the LGBTT2IQQAA community is preferred;
- concern about the safety and well being of youth of all sexual orientations and gender identities;
- a recent (within 6 months) Halton Regional Police Services Security Clearance for the Vulnerable Sector will be required prior to confirmed employment of the selected candidate(s).
